What Makes a Directive to the Recipient (DHH)? Comprehensive Planning Committee Thursday, June 15, 2023

Directives to DHH (the recipient) can be about any of the following:

- Specific subpopulations
- Specific geographic areas
- How services should be provided (service provision)
- **Types of organizations** (e.g. agencies that receive funding for and link both care and prevention services, CBO that service a particular subpopulation, nonprofit agencies, etc... **NEVER naming specific agencies**)

Recommendations from Positive Committee

- 1. Investigate capacity & feasibility for funding a new service for seniors living with HIV, such as Home Health Care.
- 2. Investigate abilities to cover certain necessities for seniors such as fall protection devices, orthopedics slippers, depends, etc.
