# 4Q Spending Summary

Reconciliation of the total invoices forwarded to the Recipient (DHH) for processing through February 29, 2024, indicated two percent (2%/\$519,726) underspending of our total overall award (includes MAI funds).

Expenditures through Q4 demonstrated underspending chiefly due to staff vacancies throughout the EMA and at the Recipient level. *Please note this 4Q report is preliminary as we are still in the process of submitting the final expenditure report.*
