

WHY JOIN A COMMITTEE?

- » It is a requirement to serve on at least one committee
- » The work of HIPC largely happens in one of its four (4) committees (not including Poz Committee)
- » Committees are smaller, more responsive forums for expressing your ideas - there is less focus on formalities
- » There is more time to delve into subjects. HIPC covers all committee topics while committee work is more focused and conversational
- » Several committee members are reaching their term limits 2025/2026 - help facilitate a smooth transition

- » Subcommittee members help the full council assess gaps in care to reach better health outcomes for PLWH, which is the ultimate goal of council work
