

WHY JOIN A COMMITTEE?

- It is a requirement to serve on at least one committee
- The work of HIPC largely happens in one of its four (4) committees (not including Poz Committee)
- Committees are smaller, more responsive forums for expressing your ideas there is less focus on formalities
- There is more time to delve into subjects. HIPC covers all committee topics while committee work is more focused and conversational
- Several committee members are reaching their term limits 2025/2026 help facilitate a smooth transition
