# U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Regional Office Locations

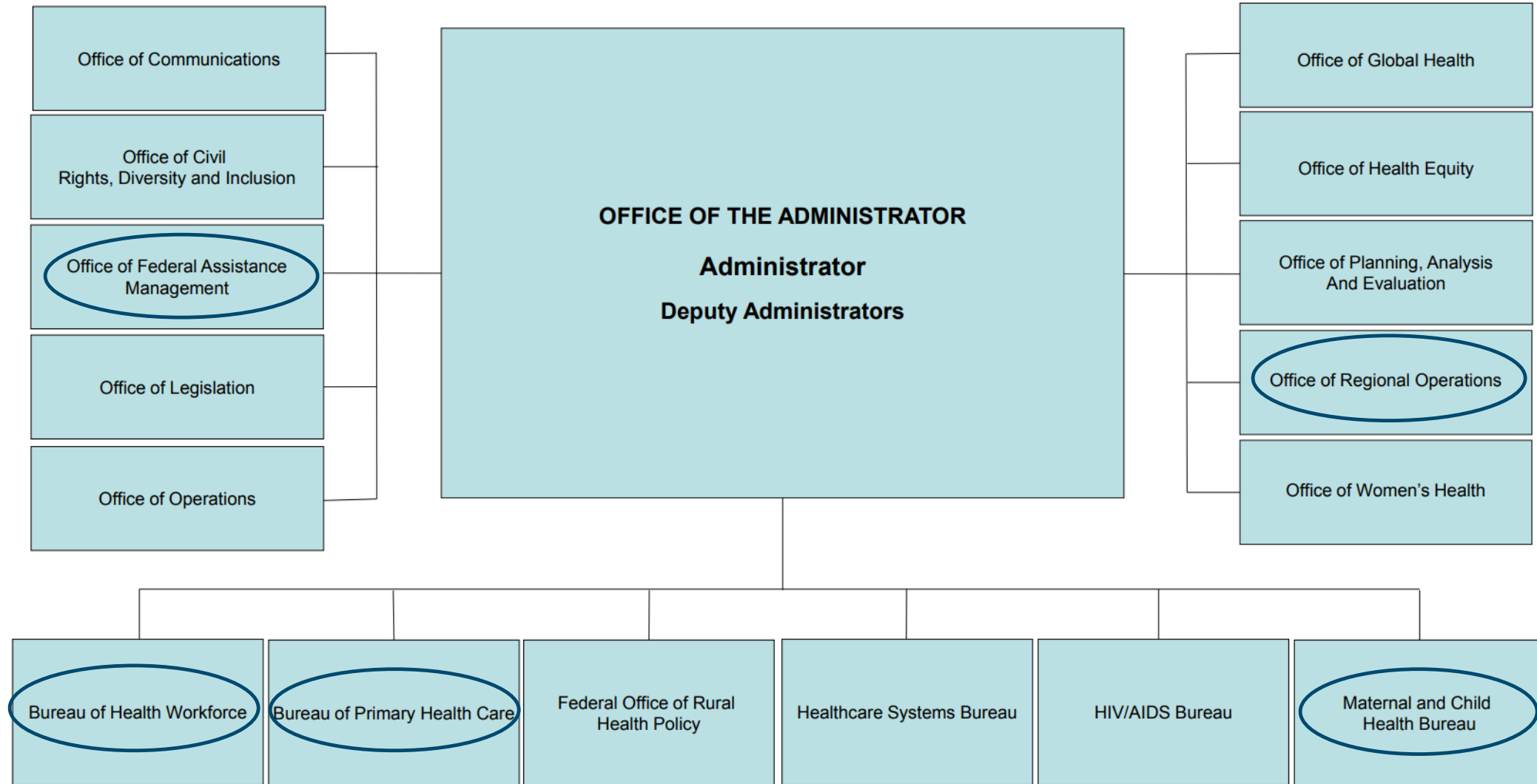


