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


Philadelphia HIV and AIDS Diagnoses, Deaths and People Living with HIV by Year




Philadelphia New HIV Diagnoses, 2019




New Diagnosed HIV by Race/Ethnicity, 2019

151% increase in new HIV diagnoses in PWID between 2016 to 2019 (33 to 83 diagnoses)




HIV Continues to Spread Among People Who Inject Drugs



Current Viral Suppression Status Among PWID by Diagnosis Month




HIV Diagnoses in the EMA

- 701 new HIV diagnoses across the EMA in 2019
 - 63% were in Philadelphia
- Late HIV diagnosis (AIDS diagnosis within 3 months of person's HIV diagnosis
 - Of persons newly diagnosed with HIV
 - 1 in 8 in were concurrent Philadelphia
 - 1 in 5 in NJ counties
 - 1 in 3 in PA counties
 - Males, blacks/AA, Hispanics, age <u>>4</u>0, and MSM heterosexuals more likely to be diagnosed late

PLWH in Philadelphia, 2019

N=18,798

- Race
 - 63.9% Black/AA
 - 15.8% Hispanic
 - 16.8% White
- Age
 - 53.6% are >50 years old
- Transmission
 - 38.2% MSM
 - 34.3% HET
 - 19.3% PWID
- Gender
 - 369 Trans Female
 - 19 Trans Male




PLWH by Census Tract, 2019



PLWH by Zip Code, Philadelphia EMA, 2019


N=27,074

- 1.7% of PLWH live in the City of Chester




PrEP Indication by Transmission Category and Race/Ethnicity



Transgender PLWH


- 369 Transgender WLWH

 - Population of Trans WLWH is younger than rest of PLWH


Race of Transgender WLWH




PrEP Awareness and Usage, Philadelphia

Ending the HIV Epidemic

Philadelphia, 2019

Philadelphia %/(Number) of people, per Surveillance	Status of Care	Accounted for X% of New Transmissions
10.3% (N=1,700)	Don't know they have HIV	39%
12.8% (N=2,125)	Know they have HIV but are not in care	36%
9.5% (N=1,573)	In care but are not virally suppressed	25%
67.4% (N=11,175)	Taking HIV medication and are virally suppressed	0.0%
